## PARTIAL SCHOLARSHIPS

Partial scholarships shall be renewable annually and offered to both full-time and part-time students who have been accepted and enrolled in a programme of study (Business, Education and Information Technology) at UWI-ROYTEC. This may cover a partial amount of tuition fees and/or incidentals.

## Eligibility

- Applicants must have met the entry requirements into UWI-ROYTEC programmes that are in excess of one-year duration.
   These scholarships shall be open to new students who have scored the highest on UWI-ROYTEC's internal admissions scoring system (with a minimum of 12 points) or in the case of continuing students, must have a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Applicants must correctly complete and submit ONE application form (Appendix I). The application must also be supported
  by the applicant's consent, or parent/guardian where applicable, to share the information with UWI-ROYTEC and its
  partners where relevant.
- Applicants must be commencing their course of study within the academic year of their application for scholarship funding.
- Applicants must submit a personal essay between 400 500 words, on why they are deserving of the award of the scholarship

(See Appendix III – Additional Scholarship Applicant Guidelines). A compelling case of financial assistance along with evidence must be submitted along with the application. Separate supporting documents will NOT be accepted at a later date.

## Criteria

As a general rule, it is expected that students receiving scholarships shall display the following attributes: -

- Scholarship applications will only be considered following an offer of admission and enrolment. Only applicants who fulfil all the eligibility criteria stated above will be considered.
- Academic Merit:
  - i. In all cases, applicants must maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0 in order to retain eligibility for Scholarships.
- Involvement in Extra-Curricular Activities:
  - ii. Applicants must provide written evidence of involvement in extra-curricular activities, through recommendation or testimonial.
- Scholarships are non-transferable.
- Should a Scholarship Holder withdraw or be asked to withdraw from the Institution on account of misconduct after accepting an award, the Awardee will be liable to repay to the Institution any monies which have been disbursed, either in whole or in part, as determined by the Committee. All reimbursements must be settled immediately upon withdrawal.
- The scholarship holder, having accepted an award, agrees to have his/her photo used by the UWI-ROYTEC for promotion, publication and marketing of its programmes and services without remuneration to the Scholarship Holder.
- Awardees already in receipt of 100% funding from any agency, would not be eligible for an award of scholarship.
- Deadlines must be strictly adhered to and any application received after the closing date will not be considered
- If, in the view of the Scholarship and Bursary Committee, there are few or no candidates of sufficient merit, UWI-ROYTEC reserves the right to withhold the disbursement of scholarships in any given period.

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
